

VERSES CONTAINING “GIVE THANKS” (33 IN THE NIV):-

1Ch 16:4 He [David] appointed some of the Levites to minister before the ark of the LORD, to make petition, to give thanks, and to praise the LORD, the God of Israel: [*This was their job*]

1Chr 16:8-36 “give thanks” four times and were formed from quoting three previously written Psalms of David

1 Chr 20:21 After consulting the people, Jehoshaphat appointed men to sing to the LORD and to praise him for the splendour of his holiness as they went out at the head of the army, saying: “Give thanks to the LORD, for his love endures forever.”

2Chr 31:2 Hezekiah assigned the priests and Levites to divisions—each of them according to their duties as priests or Levites—to offer burnt offerings and fellowship offerings, to minister, to give thanks and to sing praises at the gates of the LORD'S dwelling.

Neh 12:31 I [Nehemiah] had the leaders of Judah go up on top of the wall. I also assigned two large choirs to give thanks.

Psa 7:17 I will give thanks to the LORD because of his righteousness and will sing praise to the name of the LORD Most High.

Psa 28:7 The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and I am helped. My heart leaps for joy and I will give thanks to him in song

Psa 75:1 We give thanks to you, O God, we give thanks, for your Name is near; men tell of your wonderful deeds

Psa 100:4 Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name.

Psa 105:1 Give thanks to the LORD, call on his name; make known among the nations what he has done

Psa 106:1 Praise the LORD. Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his love endures forever.

Psa 106:47 Save us, O LORD our God, and gather us from the nations, that we may give thanks to your holy name and glory in your praise.

Psa 107:1 Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his love endures forever

Psa 107:8 Let them give thanks to the LORD for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for men,

Psa 107:15 Let them give thanks to the LORD for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for men,

Psa 107:21 Let them give thanks to the LORD for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for men.

Psa 107:31 Let them give thanks to the LORD for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for men.

Psa 118:1 Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his love endures forever

Psa 118:19 Open for me the gates of righteousness; I will enter and give thanks to the LORD.

Psa 118:29 Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his love endures forever.

Psa 136:1 Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good. His love endures forever.

Psa 136:2 Give thanks to the God of gods. His love endures forever.

Psa 136:3 Give thanks to the Lord of lords: His love endures forever.

Psa 136:26 Give thanks to the God of heaven. His love endures forever

Isa 12:4 In that day you will say: “Give thanks to the LORD, call on his name; make known among the nations what he has done, and proclaim that his name is exalted.

Jer 33:11 the sounds of joy and gladness, the voices of bride and bridegroom, and the voices of those who bring thank offerings to the house of the LORD, saying, “Give thanks to the LORD Almighty, for the LORD is good; his love endures forever.”

1Cor 10:16 Is not the cup of thanksgiving for which we give thanks a participation in the blood of Christ? And is not the bread that we break a participation in the body of Christ?

2Cor 1:11 as you help us by your prayers. Then many will give thanks on our behalf for the gracious favour granted us in answer to the prayers of many.

1The 5:18 give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

Rev 11:16 And the twenty-four elders, who were seated on their thrones before God, fell on their faces and worshiped God,

Rev 11:17 saying: "We give thanks to you, Lord God Almighty, the One who is and who was, because you have taken your great power and have begun to reign.

VERSES CONTAINING "GIVING THANKS" (7 IN THE NIV)

Psalm 100 - A Psalm. For giving thanks.

Dan 6:10 Now when Daniel learned that the decree had been published, he went home to his upstairs room where the windows opened toward Jerusalem. Three times a day he got down on his knees and prayed, giving thanks to his God, just as he had done before.

1Cor 14:16 If you are praising God with your spirit, how can one who finds himself among those who do not understand say "Amen" to your thanksgiving, since he does not know what you are saying? 1Cor 14:17 You may be giving thanks well enough, but the other man is not edified.

Eph 1:16 I have not stopped giving thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers.

Eph 5:19 Speak to one another with Psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord, Eph 5:20 always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Col 1:10 And we pray this in order that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and may please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, Col 1:11 being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience, and joyfully Col 1:12 giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light.

Col 3:17 And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him

VERSES CONTAINING "THANKSGIVING" (25 IN THE NIV)

Lev 7:13 Along with his fellowship offering of thanksgiving he is to present an offering with cakes of bread made with yeast

Lev 7:15 The meat of his fellowship offering of thanksgiving must be eaten on the day it is offered; he must leave none of it till morning.

Ezr 3:11 With praise and thanksgiving they sang to the LORD: "He is good; his love to Israel endures forever

ne 12:8 The Levites were Jeshua, Binnui, Kadmiel, Sherebiah, Judah, and also Mattaniah, who, together with his associates, was in charge of the songs of thanksgiving.

ne 12:24 And the leaders of the Levites were Hashabiah, Sherebiah, Jeshua son of Kadmiel, and their associates, who stood opposite them to give praise and thanksgiving, one section responding to the other, as prescribed by David the man of God.

Neh 12:27 At the dedication of the wall of Jerusalem, the Levites were sought out from where they lived and were brought to Jerusalem to celebrate joyfully the dedication with songs of thanksgiving and with the music of cymbals, harps and lyres.

Neh 12:46 For long ago, in the days of David and Asaph, there had been directors for the singers and for the songs of praise and thanksgiving to God.

Psa 42:4 These things I remember as I pour out my soul: how I used to go with the multitude, leading the procession to the house of God, with shouts of joy and thanksgiving among the festive throng.

Psa 69:30 I will praise God's name in song and glorify him with thanksgiving.

Psa 95:2 Let us come before him with thanksgiving and extol him with music and song.

Psa 100:4 Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise;

Psa 147:7 Sing to the LORD with thanksgiving; make music to our God on the harp.

Isa 51:3 The LORD will surely comfort Zion and will look with compassion on all her ruins; he will make her deserts like Eden, her wastelands like the garden of the LORD. Joy and gladness will be found in her, thanksgiving and the sound of singing.

Jer 30:19 From them will come songs of thanksgiving and the sound of rejoicing. I will add to their numbers, and they will not be decreased; I will bring them honour, and they will not be disdained.

Jonah 2:9 But I, with a song of thanksgiving, will sacrifice to you. What I have vowed I will make good. Salvation comes from the LORD.”

1Cor 10:16 Is not the cup of thanksgiving for which we give thanks a participation in the blood of Christ? And is not the bread that we break a participation in the body of Christ?

1Cor 14:16 If you are praising God with your spirit, how can one who finds himself among those who do not understand say “Amen” to your thanksgiving, since he does not know what you are saying?

2Cor 4:15 All this is for your benefit, so that the grace that is reaching more and more people may cause thanksgiving to overflow to the glory of God.

2Cor 9:11 You will be made rich in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God

Eph 5:4 Nor should there be obscenity, foolish talk or coarse joking, which are out of place, but rather thanksgiving.

Phil 4:6 Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.

1Tim 2:1 I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone—

1Tim 4:3 They forbid people to marry and order them to abstain from certain foods, which God created to be received with thanksgiving by those who believe and who know the truth. 1Ti 4:4 For everything God created is good, and nothing is to be rejected if it is received with thanksgiving, 1Ti 4:5 because it is consecrated by the word of God and prayer

VERSES CONTAINING “**THANKFUL**” (3 IN THE NIV)

Col 3:15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful.

Col 4:2 Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful

Heb 12:28 Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe,

VERSES CONTAINING “**THANKFULNESS**” (1 IN THE NIV)

Col 2:6-7 So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.
